Mobile Applications

Note: The OverDrive App is used for both Audiobooks and eBooks

- For whichever tablet or phone you are using, go to your app store.
- Search for the **OverDrive Media Console** app and download. This app is free.
- eBook users will be prompted to enter their **Adobe ID**. If you do not have an Adobe ID you will be able to create one. (also free)
- Once the app is downloaded, open up the application.
- From the main screen for the app, touch the menu button. Touch “Get Books” from the menu.
- Touch “Add a Website.”
- Type in **Pearl River Public Library** and select from list. PRPL is part of the Ramapo Catskill Library System.

Please Note: You must have an email and Amazon account to access OverDrive materials. See “Older Kindle” brochure for information on how to access your downloaded materials through your Amazon account.

- Select “Ramapo Catskill Library System” to add this choice to your favorites. You will only have to do this once.
- If you have a card from PRPL, make sure to “Sign-In” first at the top right of the screen. Enter the barcode number on the back of your library card and your four digit pin number (usually the last four digits of your telephone number). This will allow you to see additional titles that our library has purchased just for our patrons.
- Search using the search box or click on selected filters to help narrow your search.
- Click on “Borrow” to get book right away or “Place a Hold” to place a hold.
- If item is readily available click the “Download” button. Check your bookshelves to make sure your download is complete.
